



### Uniform at Thomas Hall School

Within our uniform policy, we have developed choice for pupils and endeavoured to make all uniform as affordable as possible. Our pupils have been involved in the design of our uniform, and we have listened to parent feedback to try and provide the best options for our community. Below is a breakdown of the requirements for both primary and secondary aged pupils.

All branded uniform can be purchased from Thomas Moore shop in Exeter. The links below should take you to all items listed in the shop.

#### Primary uniform

- Black or Green sweatshirt with Thomas Hall Logo
- Green Cardigan with Thomas Hall Logo - *optional*
- Black or White polo shirt. Branded ones are *optional*
- Grey or black skirt or shorts, knee length
- Grey or black trousers, not 'skinny', with no visible zips, studs or buckles.
- Thomas Hall School jacket (Optional)
- Black leather or leather style shoes, trainers and boots are not acceptable
- In the summer, a green gingham dress can be worn.

## **Secondary Uniform:**

Within the secondary uniform there are two distinct choices. The pupils have requested either a formal uniform, with a tie and jumper, or a more casual version. It is important that pupils do not blend uniforms, they must adopt clearly either option 1 or option 2.

### **Option 1:**

- White school shirt, worn tucked into trousers/skirt/shorts
- Green and black Thomas Hall tie, worn traditionally – Short ties and/or large knots are unacceptable
- Black Thomas Hall V-neck jumper
- Grey or black skirt or shorts, knee length
- Grey or black trousers, not 'skinny', with no visible zips, studs or buckles.
- Rucksack to carry all equipment in.
- Black leather or leather style shoes, trainers and boots are not acceptable

### **Option 2:**

- Black Thomas Hall t-shirt or polo shirt to be tucked into trousers/skirt/shorts
- Thomas Hall zip top
- Grey or black skirt or shorts, knee length
- Grey or black trousers, not 'skinny', with no visible zips, studs or buckles.
- Rucksack to carry all equipment in.
- Black leather or leather style shoes, trainers and boots are not acceptable



## PE Primary Uniform at Thomas Hall School

Physical Education (PE) kit requirements for our Primary pupils. Please take note of the following guidelines to ensure your child is properly equipped for their PE lessons.

### PE Kit Requirements:

- **Thomas Hall School PE T-shirt:** This should be house-coloured, depending on your child's school house.
- **Bottoms:** Plain black shorts, skorts, leggings, or tracksuit bottoms.
- **Footwear:** Suitable PE trainers or plimsolls.
- **Outerwear:** The normal Thomas Hall school jumper can be worn over the top.

**On their designated PE day, pupils are allowed to arrive at school in their PE kit and remain in it for the duration of the day. This will facilitate easier transitions and ensure students are comfortable throughout their PE activities.**

### Health and Safety Guidelines:

- **Jewellery:** Hooped or long earrings must be removed. Stud earrings may need to be removed if deemed necessary by the teacher or sport. If removal is not possible, please ensure your child has their own sterile tape to cover them.
- **Hair:** Long hair should be tied back, for the duration of the day or a hair band is provided to do so prior to the lesson.
- **Grip Socks:** We advise students to bring a pair of grip socks on their PE days. This is to ensure safety while using the gymnasium, especially for those who may not like bare feet or have medical conditions such as a verruca or injury to the foot.

## PE Secondary Uniform at Thomas Hall School

It is important that all students are equipped appropriately to ensure comfort, safety, and uniformity during PE lessons.

### Required PE Kit:

1. **Thomas Hall PE Polo Top:** This is mandatory for all students.
2. **Bottoms:** Students are expected to wear either Thomas Hall PE Shorts, Skort, Joggers, or Leggings. To support families, we will also accept plain black shorts, skorts, joggers, or leggings. Plain means that other than a small, branded logo, no other designs should be visible.
3. **Footwear:** Suitable trainers that provide adequate support for running are required. Boots and leather school shoes are not allowed.

### Additional Items:

1. **Grip Socks:** Due to safety considerations in our gymnasium, students should either wear bare feet or grip socks. It is advisable for students to bring grip socks to each PE lesson as a precaution.
2. **Thomas Hall PE Zip-Up Top:** This should be used as a warm layer. Non-Thomas Hall jumpers will not be permitted.

### Health and Safety Requirements:

From September 2025, Students who have PE lessons can come into school wearing their PE kit. Please note that this must be the Thomas Hall School PE kit only. Teachers will follow the normal uniform guidance if pupils are not in the correct PE kit on the specified day.

- Long hair must be tied up, so students should bring a hair band.
- Long and hooped earrings need to be removed. Stud earrings may need to be removed depending on the sport and teacher discretion. If removal is not possible, students should bring and use their own sterile tape to cover them.
- All other jewellery should be removed, with the exception of a sports watch.

Note for Year 10 and 11 Sports Studies Students: Students enrolled in the Sports Studies course are permitted to order and wear the designated VX3 Sports Studies kit as a replacement for the standard Thomas Hall PE Kit. This exception applies only to those undertaking the Sports Studies course, further information will be sent out separately to these students.

## **Other Guidance:**

### Shoes and socks

- Shoes should be plain black and leather or leather-type with plain black laces. Boots or trainers are not permitted

### Jewellery & Piercings

- Only religious necklaces should be worn, these should be worn inside the shirt for safety reasons.
- Pupils are permitted to wear one pair of stud earrings, silver or gold in colour. All other piercings must be removed.
- Pupils are not permitted to display any body art during school time.

### Hair and Make up

- Hair must be of a broadly natural colour, extreme hairstyles are not permitted. Borders and patterns must not be shaved into the hair or eyebrows.
- Pupils must not wear makeup, nail varnish or false nails while in school

### Hoodies

- Hoodies should not be worn on school site in either Primary or Secondary phases and will be confiscated at the beginning of the day by the class teacher or tutor.

### Essential Items:

- Weather appropriate clothing (raincoat or umbrella if necessary)
- A waterproof bag/rucksack, preferably with two shoulder straps (small bags and handbags are not permitted)
- PE Kit
- Stationery: Two black or blue pens, pencil, ruler, rubber, colouring pencils
- Additional Upper School stationery: Scientific calculator and protractor set, highlighters

For outdoor pursuits, we recommended that pupils have a Thomas Hall jacket – however, this is optional.
